Hello,

Keeping you updated about our improvements at Hodder Water Treatment Works – Delivery of large machinery and associated equipment.

We wanted to provide an update on our project at Hodder Water Treatment Works. The main construction works are ongoing and are expected to be completed by autumn 2022 with landscaping works to be carried out in 2023.

Highways update and access through Slaidburn Village:

As some customers may be aware, the main route to site for all major deliveries has been the north route, from Bentham. However, on W/C Monday 15 March the project requires the delivery of a large piling rig and due to its size, consider The Skaithe route unsuitable.

Therefore, for the safety of all involved, we will be transporting the rig using a temporary, alternative route - passing through the following areas:

A59 – Worston Road – Crowtree Brow towards Chatburn – Chatburn - Grindleton - West Bradford – Waddington – Newton in Bowland – Slaidburn – Hodder. Please see the access route map on the next page.

How will this affect me?

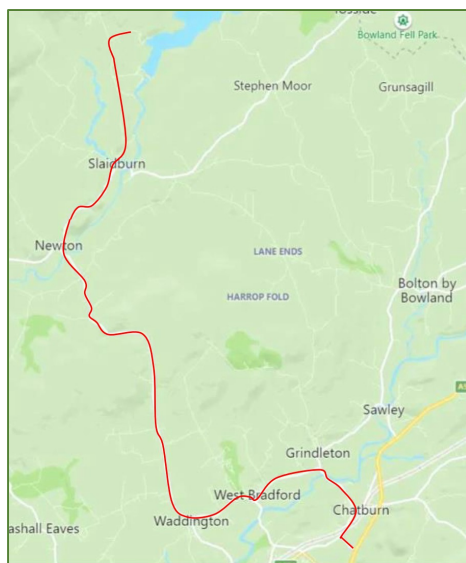
Trial run:

- To ensure the large vehicle can manage the route and for the safety of all involved, we have planned a trial run on Monday 15 March between the hours of 9.15am and 3.15pm, with an empty load and convoy. Depending on the success of this trial run, the piling rig will then be transported on Tuesday 16 March, using the same approach.

Transporting piling rig:

- The equipment will be transported between the hours of 9.15am and 3pm.
- Due to the size of the machinery it will be escorted using convoy vehicles. They will maintain a low speed at all times.

- The piling rig will be removed from site approximately one week later, using the same route and will again be escorted.
- Along with the piling rig, we also need to transport large metal sheets – these will be delivered using the same route and have been restricted to two deliveries per day, for a total of 4 days - starting week commencing Monday 15 March.
- During this week, and to keep any disruption to a minimum, we have also stopped all other deliveries to site.



Should any issues occur on Monday 15 March which, delays the transport of the piling rig, we will write to you in advance, providing a revised date.

We understand the sensitivity of passing through residential areas and can assure you that we are doing all we can to reduce the impact. We thank you for your ongoing patience.
